

「NTUST Guidelines on Grants for English Proficiency Tests」

Planning for handling the buffer period of the old regulations to the new regulations

1. Objectives: This guideline aims to provide a buffer period for NTUST students who have taken the English proficiency test (CERF B1 level). Due to the fact that the old NTUST Guidelines on Grants for English Proficiency Tests have been abolished, students who have a CERF B1 certificate would not be able to apply for the grants. This plan would allow students to apply for the grants in the first semester of the 111 school year.

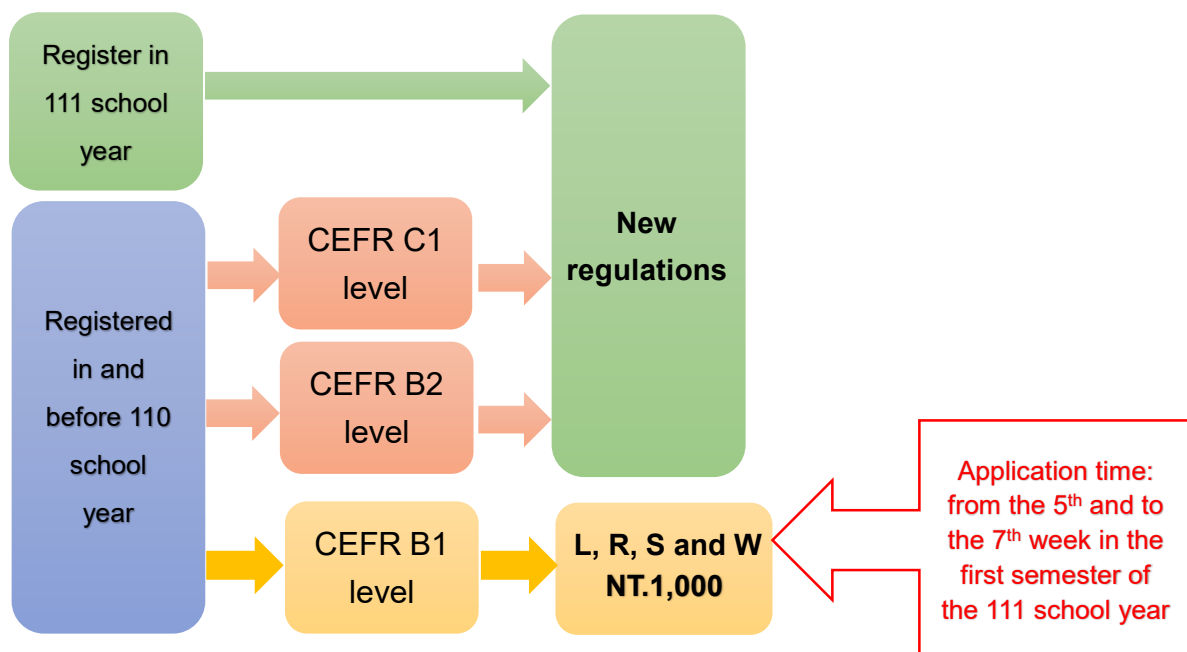
2. Remedial measures:

- (1) **Application time:** From the 5th to the 7th week (10/3/2022 to 10/21,2022). The 8th week is for review. Late applications will not be reviewed.
- (2) **How to apply:** Only **ONLINE** application is accepted.
- (3) **Eligibility:** **NTUST students who have registered before 110 school year** (Students from the Department of Applied Foreign Languages are not considered).
- (4) **Conditions of Application:** Those who have completed the CERF B1 level English test (It is required to upload a photocopy of the certification of study from the NTUST online student information system.) before 8/1/2022 and who have never applied for other grants from other units of this school in the duplicate application.

3. Duration of implementation: From the 5th to the 7th week (10/3/2022 to 10/21,2022).

4. Application:

- (1) New students: Students who register in the 111 school year are only eligible for the new guideline. (see Appendix for the new guideline)
- (2) Continuing students: Students who have registered in and before the 110 school year and have not yet applied for the grants for CEFR B1 level are able to apply.



5. This plan is only implemented in the first semester of the 111 school year in principal. Late applications and applications with missing files are not reviewed.
